Help spread the word! NSC has 4 mooring opportunities available (membership required) for power boats on our downstream dock. With mooring and the cost of club membership combined approximately \$675, this is an incredible opportunity for potential new members with boats.

With the assistance of Steve Webb and Ray Dan Jumbo, I inventoried the NSC property of all boats, jet skis, empty trailers and other various and sundry items stored in our property. We now have a comprehen-

sive list of all items. We are storing 64 boats and jet skis at present. This count does not include the trailers that these vessels are residing on. Many of the boats are member-owned and used seasonally. The vast majority are not, though, nor have these items been maintained in any way for years. In the end, these unused items become a nuisance, a waste of resources, a liability and an expense to the club.

If you know of anyone who is no longer a club member and who has a boat on our property, please give that person a heads up, or email me at jtucker0211@gmail.com so that I can reach out. We, of course, will give that former member a window of opportunity to remove their boat off club property before we assume ownership and determine what to do with it.

As soon as the ground clears a bit, we will inventory-tag all club-owned or abandoned boats and trailers. Those items that we identify as club-owned, or abandoned, that are no longer sea-worthy or just plain junk, will be tagged by an orange tag and identified as "Trash". We will try and get these to-be-junked items in one area of the back-forty during the summer and we will decide what we will do with those items. We might just organize a chain saw demo party. Watch for a party flyer!

Needless to say, please keep me (or future Fleet Captains) fully informed of any boats or other items coming or going from club property.

Pattie and I inventoried winter storage and have since sent out invoices to club members who are currently storing their boats in the back forty. Your prompt payment of those storage fees will be appreciated.

We also have lockers available in the club basement if any club member would like to rent one for storage of life jackets, tubes, pool toys, etc. Just let me know. Locker Rentals are \$25 or \$35 (larger wooden lockers) for the year.

I appreciate all club basin users who returned the Summer 2020 Dock/Locker Request Form to me. If you have not returned this form to me, and plan on mooring your boat/jet ski in our basin, please take a minute to do that soon.

The Bar is a major benefit available to all NSC club members and generates a substantial amount of money for the club. Not many clubs allow members to use the bar without a bartender on duty. The accuracy and honesty of all members using the bar is essential to helping the club stay profitable. In the past few months the club has not collected the proper amount of money for the quantity of what has been re-stocked. Some specific problems have been identified. The dollar amount for premium beer is not consistently being marked on chits. Hayburners are \$4.00 and the All Day IPAs are \$3.00. Also, for some reason the Labatts Blue stock is not matching the chits and cash that is being collected. It is imperative that all NSC club members accurately account and pay for what they take and follow the club rules when using the bar. When you use the club for small gatherings or meetings, please purchase all beverages including sodas from the NSC bar. Bringing your own drinks and coolers to the club is discouraged. The cost of our drinks at NSC is generally lower than any other place in the Buffalo area.

Please support NSC! Use the bar and use it honestly and accurately.


